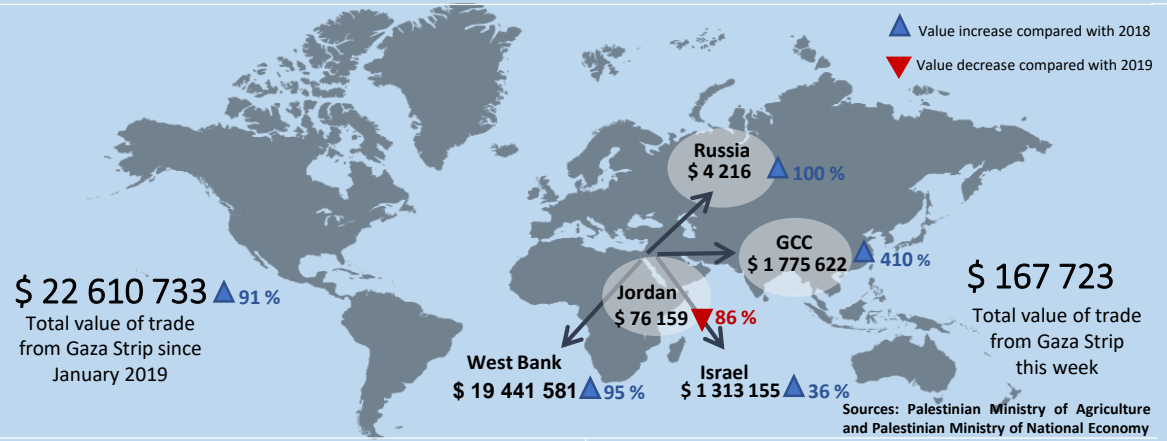

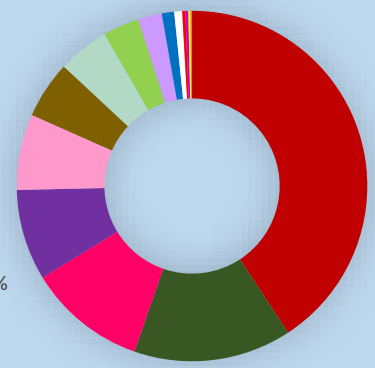

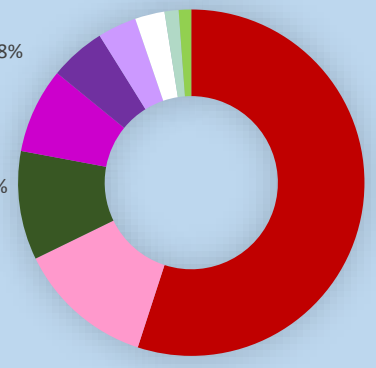

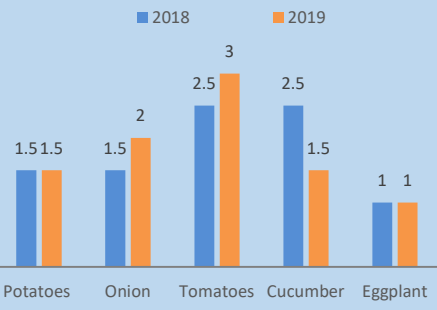

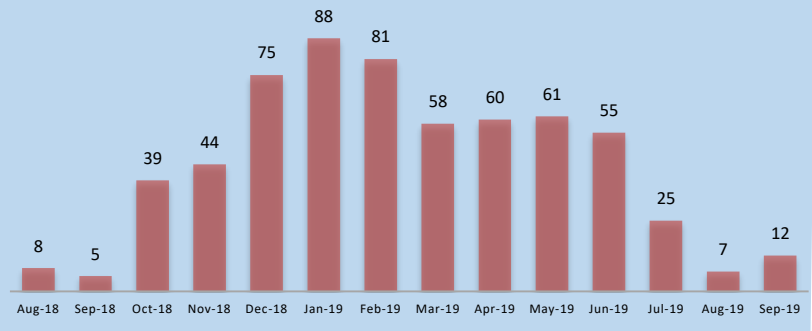

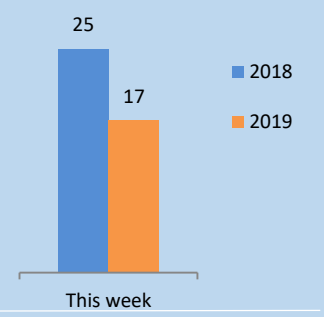
### Main crops prices (NIS/KG) this week 2018 vs. 2019



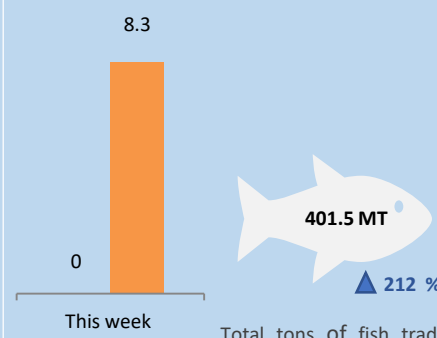
### Weekly average truckloads per month
